During the concerts this year City Staff has volunteered their time to sell concessions to help raise money for the Veteran’s Memorial.

The City would like to dispose of the 2004 Ford Expedition. It’s had a lot of problems and it’s no longer feasible to try and fix. The City would like to purchase a vehicle for the Parks Department not to exceed \$10,000. We have brought in about \$13,000 in asset disposal sales so this would not affect the budget.

The sewer allocation was approved from the County and they are currently working out a cost to be billed to the developer.
