2013 ANNUAL STATISTICS

SUMMARY OF 2013 STATISTICS

In the area of law enforcement in 2013, the City of Locust continued to be "a wonderful place to live, work, and play!" Statistics documented by the Locust Police Department for the 2013 calendar year showed a decrease overall in dispatched call types, as well as offense types related to calls.

For the year, the Locust Police Department continued with its policies of reports being documented for dispatched calls where interaction with the public occurred. With that policy, the department still showed a 16.6% decrease in incident reports documented compared to 2012, as well as a 15.8% decrease in offense types related to dispatched calls.

General service call types were down 17.1% from the previous year, and general investigation call types were 7.4% lower. In general investigations, reports of missing persons increased from one to twelve for the year. It should be noted however, that no missing person reports involved foul play or legitimate run-away activity, and all reported missing were located.

Most positively, call types related to criminal activity were also down for 2013. Property and financial crime call types were down 6.6% from last year. Within this category: reports related to larcenies from businesses went up by just nine reports from a year ago, larcenies from residences were up just two reports, and fraud reports only up by four from 2012. Conversely, reports related to larcenies from vehicles dropped a hefty 65.4% from 52 in 2012 to 18 in 2013. Overall larceny activity for the year still only showed an average daily occurrence in the city of 0.48, with a decrease of 10.3% for the year. Personal larceny activity reports related to persons, vehicles or residences were down 35.2% from last year, and had an average daily occurrence of a mere 0.16 in Locust.

General law enforcement/criminal activity call types were down 19.7%. In this category, reports of trespassing increased quite a bit, however mostly were related to previous offenders returning unlawfully to Wal-Mart. Call types related to alcohol and drugs also showed a decrease of 40.3%. In the category related to assaults reported, a large drop from 48 to 17 was seen for the year. This represented a 64.6% drop from 2012, and occurred for the year on an average of just 0.05 times daily in the city.

Serious crime reports did go up from a year ago however some insight should be given into those reports. Reports related to sexual offenses were six for the year. It should be noted however, that these reports were documented even if the offense was determined to occur in another jurisdiction, or if the reports were unconfirmed. Personal larceny/robbery report types were three for the year. Noted in this report type, two of the offense types were related to the attempted robbery at the 901 North Central Fast Shop location in the summer of 2013. All three suspects in that report were apprehended a short time after the incident occurred. The other report was an alleged "snatch and run" incident that occurred outside of a Locust bank.

In March of 2012, the Locust Police Department implemented a strategy of patrolling neighborhoods and businesses more efficiently. These patrols; one of the cornerstones of the department's philosophy in community policing, were altered in a way that the city could still be patrolled effectively, yet at the same time reduce the expense related to the consistently elevated price of fuel as well as vehicle wear and tear. This new strategy did result in a decrease in documented patrols of Locust neighborhoods and businesses compared to 2012 however, 20,875 neighborhood and business patrols were still completed for the 2013 calendar year. Within the perspective of daily patrols; this represented just a decrease of 4.7 patrols conducted on average daily by the department this year as opposed to last. The result of the more efficient patrol strategy resulted in just a small decrease in daily patrols, yet contributed greatly to the department's fuel costs decreasing by an average of 8.4% per patrol vehicle, and overall patrol vehicle expenditures decreasing by 6% on average per patrol vehicle (based on 2012/2013 budget year report).

Arrest charges in 2013 were 128, down from 199 in 2012. This 35.7% decrease can partially be attributed to the 17% decrease in dispatched calls resulting in incident reports. These charge numbers also do not include offenders in investigations where arrest warrants were obtained, however another agency located the suspect at a later date and made the arrest. This charge number could also consider that less individuals committed offenses in the city that resulted in arrest during 2013.

Traffic safety and enforcement remained a priority for the Locust Police Department in 2013, with the primary goal of keeping Locust residents and all motorists safe. Citation charges were up 13.9% for the year; from 1056 in 2012 to 1204 in 2013. It should be noted that a report error last year resulted in the September 2012 citation charges not being included in the annual report. Despite that, with a monthly average this past year of 100.3, the difference from 2012 to 2013 of 148 would still indicate an increase in citation charges issued for the year.
