

# LOCUST POLICE DEPARTMENT 2016 ANNUAL STATISTICS

### SUMMARY OF 2016 STATISTICS

#### OFFENSE TYPES/INCIDENT REPORTS

Law enforcement activities in the city of Locust for 2016 resulted in a banner year for the city in terms of low criminal activity, and continued to show that city residents and visitors enjoy a safe environment, and a peaceful atmosphere for a city that is showing obvious signs of growth. Statistics documented by the Locust Police Department for the 2016 calendar year showed roughly a 5% decrease in documented offense types and recorded incident reports, a decrease in overall larceny and fraud activity, and continued with an extremely small average daily occurrence of reported larceny or assault activity.

For the year, the Locust Police Department continued with its policies of reports being documented for dispatched calls where interaction with the public occurred. This still resulted in the aforementioned 5.3% decrease in documented incident reports compared to 2015, and reported offenses documented in those reports decreased by 4.6% from the previous year.

General service call types were down 6.9% from the previous year, and these non-criminal call types continue to represent the largest percentage of dispatched calls received. EMS and Fire calls where the department assisted did increase by 12% which can continue to be expected as the city grows as well as due to residents native to Locust continuing to grow older.

General investigation call types were also down 2.9% from the previous year. Calls considered as general investigation are also often non-criminal in nature but do require investigation by the department to determine. Of note in this category, disturbance call types were down 3.6%. Two missing person reports for the year were not determined to involve foul play and those "missing" were located.

General law enforcement/criminal activity offense types that were reported decreased by 3.2% for 2016. Decreases were seen in traffic offenses that required an incident report, trespassing, vandalism, and the "other illegal activity" categories. Slight increases were seen in the property damage, warrants, harassment, and weapons violations categories.

Some of the most promising statistics were seen in the category involving call types related to property and financial crime. Overall, there was a 15.6% decrease in call types related to theft or fraud. Breaking this down further, there was a 15.2% drop in business related larcenies, a 6.9% decrease in fraud type reports, and a 62.1% decrease in larcenies from vehicles with only 11 reported for the year. There was a 26.3% increase in thefts related to residences however the total number was only increased by 5 for the year from 19 in 2015 to 24 in 2016. Overall, personal larceny affecting persons, vehicles, or residences continued to be extremely low showing a daily average occurrence of just 0.10.

Alcohol and drug related offense types increased by 16.7% for the year from 108 in 2015 to 126 in 2016. The only notable increase within this section is the 44.8% increase in reported DWI offense types. Reported DWI offense types would represent incidents where arrests were made.

More promising statistics were seen in the physical crime category as only 19 assault type offenses were reported for the year, a decrease of 40.6%. This statistic represents a daily average reported occurrence in Locust of just .05 times.

Other offense types reported for 2016 were 5 sex offenses and 1 death investigation. The sex offenses reported either were confirmed to be unfounded or an arrest was made. The death investigation was believed to not involve foul play however autopsy results to confirm investigative findings was not yet available as of the time of this report.

#### BUSINESS/NEIGHBORHOOD PATROLS

For 2016, business and neighborhood patrols logged by the department increased by nearly 300 to 18,417 for the year. This number continues to show a dedication by the department to adequately patrol businesses and neighborhoods in the city. This represented a logged patrol average of Locust businesses and neighborhoods of 50.5 daily, up from the 49.6 average in 2015.

#### ARREST CHARGES

Arrest charges made by the Locust Police Department in 2016 remained relatively similar to the number of charges in 2015. For the year, the Locust Police Department made 263 arrest charges, nine less than in 2015 for a decrease of 3.3%. The three usual charge types again topped the stat list with driving while impaired, failure to appear, and misdemeanor larceny charges leading the way. As seen compared to the high overall activity numbers for the year listed below, this statistical decrease is a positive one indicating less criminal activity in a growing city for the 2016 calendar year.

#### **CITATION CHARGES**

Citation charges for 2016 saw an increase which would indicate increased traffic enforcement for the year by Locust officers, continued increases in traffic through the Locust area, or a combination of both. An overall 28.4% increase in citation charges were recorded compared to 2015 and represented 1,439 total citation charges. Increases were seen in every citation category utilized in statistical tracking with the exception of the general criminal offense category that recorded the same number of charges as the previous year. Locust officers continued to show efficient use of police discretion as well with averages showing 119.9 citation charges issued monthly and an average of 113.8 warnings issued also monthly.

#### TRAFFIC CRASHES

Traffic crashes reported in the city for 2016 were 220, up a significant 43.8% from the previous year when reported crashes were at 153. This total number would include all reported crashes which would also represent parking lot fender benders. The increase of 67 reported crashes for the year however would include a significant number of reported crashes on streets or highways in Locust. This increase may or may not be related to the traveling speed limit through Locust being changed to 45 mph the previous year, increased traffic flow through the Locust area overall, or the need for additional traffic control at certain intersections in the city

such as Meadowcreek Church Road or Browns Hill Road and West Main Street. A more in-depth look at crash report locations and factors was not conducted due to deficiencies in how statistical reports on crashes are produced in the current system and in the interest of time in having this annual report produced without further delay.

#### **OVERALL LAW ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY**

Overall, numbers related to dispatched calls and case numbers generated in 2016 compared to 2015 is where the growth of the city is most evident. In total, 5,585 calls were either dispatched to or initiated by the Locust Police Department in 2016, a 9.4% increase from the previous year. Additionally, case or incident numbers generated by the department in 2016 were 2,869, a 7.9% increase from 2015. As the city continues to grow in population and economic development, these numbers will continue to increase which would warrant consideration of additional staffing for the Locust Police Department in the near future.
