# TOTAL DISPATCHED/ATTENDED/INITIATED LPD EVENTS

NEW IN 2024 – Due to record call volumes and continued city growth, Locust officers are no longer required to complete certain non-criminal incident reports unless requested by an involved party. In order to continue to assess the frequency and types of calls Locust officers are responding to, a log of all dispatched/attended/initiated calls by the Locust Police Department will be logged and reported monthly. ## INCIDENTS/OFFENSES WITH REPORTS REQUIRED

Note – Total incident reports generated number will be lower than number of offenses/incidents listed. This is due to there being multiple offenses within one report on some occasions, particularly in criminal activity calls. **NEW IN 2024** – Due to record call volumes and continued city growth, certain non-criminal incident reports that meet specific criteria are no longer required to be completed by Locust officers. As a result, overall incident report and offense type totals will likely be lower than in years past, with several call types that in the past would have generated a report and be present in this list will be greatly reduced in most occasions (i.e. False Alarms, General Medical Calls, Calls For Service etc.).
